

Design Miami 2023: installations, exhibitions and works of art

More than 40 presentations and more than 20 brand collaborations reveal the nineteenth edition of Design Miami

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“Where We Stand”: this year's key theme

This motto underlines the importance of design, which is celebrated by highlighting its role in explaining the world and helping us understand its current dynamics. Design, in this sense, is in fact considered a powerful tool that tells stories and their interweavings. A way to discover new realities and new cultures that mix together to create the present and then the future. The rather engaging installations aim to explain the importance of human connection through articles and objects from various places in the world.

The artists present and their collections

Numerous artists are ready to proudly display their works. Among them, Victoria Yakusha, who presents "The Land of Light", a limited edition collection that focuses on a very particular technique for finishing walls: the objects are structured, vibrant and very linked to the Ukrainian lands of origin; Maison Gerard explores human connection through some contemporary designers (Ayala Serfaty, Aline Hazarian, Carol Egan...); Hostler Burrows exhibits the work of some Nordic artists and designers, such as Huotari's beaded ceramic chair, Hanna Hansdotter's new glass sculptures and Kristina Riska's sculptures.

Then again, a section of the exhibition is dedicated entirely to the display of objects inspired by nature, for example the works of Adrian Sassoon. A design that convinces, that makes you think, and that above all helps modern man in his vision and understanding of the world and its dynamics.
